SVEA Show Rules

1. The show will be run in accordance with HCBC & Equine Canada rules.
2. All riders must be a member of BC Horse Council and provide proof of such.
3. Approved hard hats and boots with heels are mandatory.
4. Proper Show attire is required and Jackets recommended out of respect for the judge
5. Classes may be combined or cancelled at management discretion.
6. All dogs must be on leash at all times.
7. No pedestrians inside arenas. Please coach from the rail unless setting jumps or an emergency occurs.
8. Ribbons to 6th place.
9. Classes with only one participant will not receive ribbons.

Class Descriptions

English Pleasure

Horses are judged on their manners, performance, quality and conformation. The horse is to give the impression of being a pleasure to ride.

Equitation

Based on the riders seat and position. May be asked to sit the trot, two-point, halt or drop the stirrups.

Hunter Under Saddle

This class is judged primarily on the horse's way of going, conformation, and their manners. Their legs should swing and reach easily and freely with their feet landing quietly.

Road Hack

Emphasis is placed on the horse's suitability for road riding, extended movements, and manners. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. The judge may ask for an extended trot, hand gallop, or halt and back up.

Hunter Hack

Competitors are judged on the flat and over two fences. Scored on horse's manners, gait and conformation as well as their ability to jump in an even arc and stride. The flat phase will include walk trot, canter. Competitors must be required to jump a line of two cross rails from a trot approach and may be asked to halt after these fences or circle.

Lead Line Costume Class

Dress the rider, Dress your horse! Anything goes! Riders must incorporate helmet into their costume attire.

Champion and Reserve Champion Year End Awards

Ribbons awarded to 6th place

To qualify for year end divisional awards, you must show in a complete division
